NOTES:

- 1) THE INTENT OF THIS GRAPHIC IS TO DEPICT PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE CIRCULATION ALONG THE ARTERIAL AND COLLECTOR ROADWAY NETWORK. FOR CLARITY, SIDEWALKS ON LOCAL STREETS ARE NOT SHOWN. HOWEVER, ALL LOCAL STREETS SHALL HAVE 5 FOOT CONCRETE SIDEWALKS ON BOTH SIDES.
- 2) IN ADDITION TO MULTI-USE PATHS SHOWN, SUNLAKE BOULEVARD WILL ALSO HAVE A 4 FOOT PAVED BICYCLE LANE IN EACH DIRECTION.
- 3) MANY OF THE INDIVIDUAL PARCEL ENTRANCE ROADWAYS, INCLUDING THE ENTRANCES TO VILLAGE 1, VILLAGE 2 PARCEL A, VILLAGE 2 PARCEL C, VILLAGE 4, VILLAGE 6 PARCEL A, AND VILLAGE 8 ARE DEPICTED AS DIVIDED ENTRYWAYS WITH MEDIANS. IT SHOULD NOT BE CONSTRUED THAT THESE ARE REQUIRED OR INTENDED TO BE SUBDIVISION COLLECTOR ROADWAYS REQUIRING BICYCLE LANES OR PATHS. THESE STREETS ARE CLASSIFIED AS TYPE 2 ROADWAYS, AND REQUIRE ONLY SIDEWALKS PURSUANT TO THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE. THE DEVELOPER HAS ELECTED TO DIVIDE THESE ENTRANCES TO PROVIDE FOR SIGNING AND LANDSCAPE OPPORTUNITIES.
- 4) THIS PLAN IS INTENDED TO INDICATE THE GENERAL LOCATION OF PROPOSED SIDEWALKS, PATHS, AND TRAILS, AND IS NOT INTENDED TO ADDRESS SPECIFIC ALIGNMENT GEOMETRY FOR THEM. SPECIFIC GEOMETRY WILL BE ADDRESSED AT THE TIME OF PRELIMINARY AND/OR PRELIMINARY/CONSTRUCTION PLAN SUBMISSION FOR EACH PHASE OR INCREMENT OF PROPOSED INFRASTRUCTURE CONSTRUCTION.
