**Public Notice of the Intent of Pasco County to Seek FEMA Funding for the
Acquisition and Demolition of 8823 Wavyedge Ct Trinity, FL**

Project #FMA-2017-015

Notification is hereby given to the public of the intent of Pasco County to seek FEMA grant funds for the acquisition and demolition of a flood-prone property. The proposed undertaking is within the 100-year floodplain; the structures will be demolished and deed restrictions will prohibit future development and sites will be maintained in perpetuity as open space under Pasco County's ownership.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements, and conditions. This project may affect the wetlands or floodplains in the proposed areas. Because of this, the following alternatives were considered:

- The "no action alternative" was determined to not be the best solution as it would leave the properties prone to flooding. Continued inaction would place undue burdens on both the homeowner and the National Flood Insurance Program.
- A "mitigation reconstruction" (Tear down and rebuild) project was considered but was determined to not be cost effective.
