This is an opportunity for the members of the Committee and the public to become acquainted with the duties, responsibilities, and services provided by all the entities that form Pasco County government.

Following the meeting on August 10, 2015, the Charter Advisory Committee will decide if Pasco County should pursue a charter form of government. We will be presenting our findings to the Board of County Commissioners during the Board meeting on August 18, 2015.
