Pasco County Electronics Recycling Program

Electronics contain over 1,000 materials. Many of these materials can be hazardous including, chlorinated solvents, brominated flame retardants, PVC, heavy metals, plastic, glass and gases. Electronics should not be comingled with household trash.

The improper disposal of electronic waste, E-waste, can create an environmental hazard, so it is important that our residents recycle their electronics.

Pasco County was the first county in the state of Florida and one of only a handful of counties nationally to implement an electronic equipment de-manufacturing program. Nationally only about 25% of end of life electronics are recycled.

Benefits to Recycling

- Conservation of valuable resources, precious metals, steel, aluminum, and plastic.
- Saves valuable landfill space.
- Reduces lead emissions from incinerators, thus reducing air pollution.

TV's larger than 36" are \$10.00 per item. There is no charge for items such as printers, fax machines, etc.
