 - **Went over Pasco Mapper which will be replacing PascoView**
 - **General presentation of how to work Pasco Mapper from a public perspective**
 - **Showed tips and tricks to better serve homeowners and departments completing projects or researching areas of Pasco**
 - **GIS would allow municipalities to submit data to Pasco County to include in the Pasco Mapper; however it data updates would be the municipals responsibility**

 - **GIS conducting on-going training sessions on Pasco Mapper for future dates**

- **LMS Updates:**
 - Final edits for the HIRA are being completed by EM staff as voted on during the December meeting
 - Master Project List shows a total of approximately 200 projects with approximately 150 in “active” status
 - 43 of these have either been completed, will not be funded, County cannot complete, or homeowners voluntarily opted out of the program and will be considered “retired” as of this meeting (see powerpoint for specifics)
 - Ian Eppig requested that group vote on approval of current revisions to the Mitigation Strategy Section for the five-year update and allow EM to complete all remaining final edits/revisions prior to submittal to Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM)
